A VERMONT STATE PARK Visitor's Pass Discount Program For Seniors and Veterans

To be eligible for a life-long State Parks Passport, a person must be:

- A legal resident of Vermont and the municipality where the application is made, **AND** either
 - 62 years of age or older, or
 - a veteran of the uniformed services

Use your Green Mountain Passport for:

- Admission to Vermont State Parks (overnight camping and other park fees **are excluded**)
- Vermont State Historic Sites
- Events which are fully State sponsored

To receive a **Green Mountain Passport** card:

- Fill out an **application** at your local **City or Town Clerk's Office**
- Submit the \$2.00 fee to the municipal clerk
- Receive your Green Mountain Passport card
- It's that easy!
