- BURLINGTON COUNTRY CLUB STORMWATER PROJECT: Construction of a stormwater gravel
 wetland on Burlington Country Club property is scheduled to begin on August 29th. This project
 is a collaboration between the City of South Burlington and the Burlington Country Club.
 Stormwater runoff from Spear Street will be treated in the new gravel wetland. The project will
 impact the multi-use path that runs parallel to Spear Street, in the vicinity of the UVM Miller
 Research Farm and Bio Research Complex. A detour along the multi-use path will keep access
 for bike and pedestrian thru-traffic while the path is impacted.
- LINDENWOOD DRIVE STORMWATER PROJECT: Construction of a stormwater collection system and stormwater treatment pond along Lindenwood Drive is scheduled to begin on August 29th. The project will require closure of the multi-use path connecting Lindenwood Drive to Farrell Park and all bike and pedestrian traffic will need to use a marked detour along Swift Street. A schedule for the necessary path detour will be posted on the City's stormwater website.
- STONEHEDGE SWALE IMPROVEMENTS: Maintenance and dredging of an existing drainage swale between Stonehedge Dr and the Szymanski Park stormwater pond is scheduled to begin on August 22. The work is anticipated to take up to two weeks to complete, concluding in early September.
